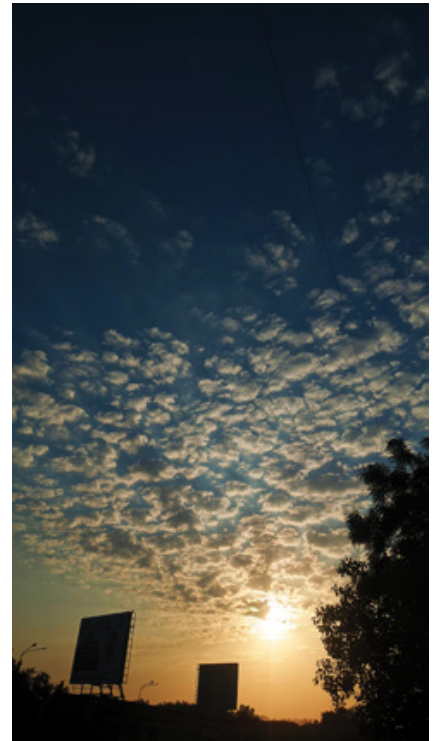
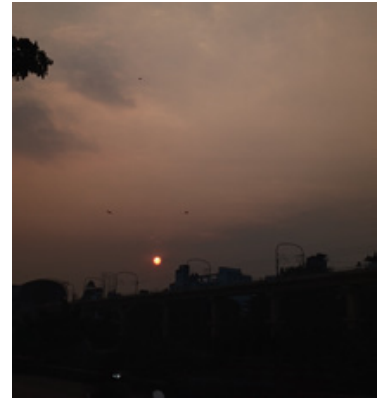
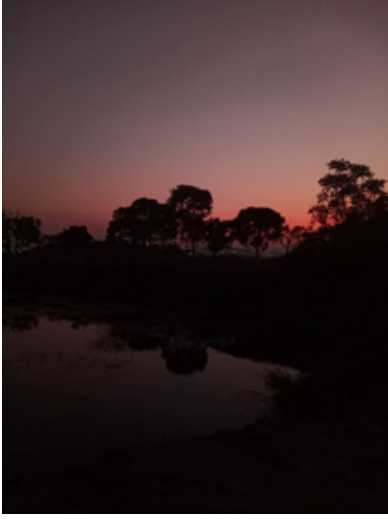


Glimpses of Pune



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वाचलं म्हणून वाचलो ! (माझ्या आयुष्यातील पुस्तकांचे योगदान)

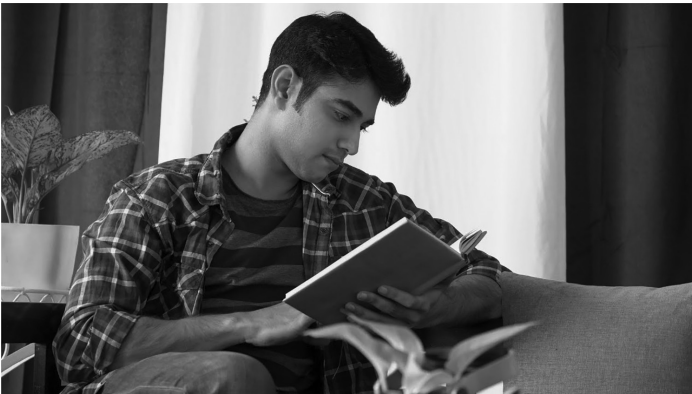

आपण आपलं आयुष्य आनंदात, सुखाने आणि समाधानाने जगावं असं प्रत्येकाला वाटत असतं. त्यासाठी ती व्यक्ती प्रयत्नशील असते. जगातील सर्व सुख-समाधान, आनंद मिळावा यासाठी अथक परिश्रम घेते. हे सर्व सत्य असले तरी तिला एक प्रश्न नेहमीच छळत असतो तो म्हणजे, 'आयुष्य म्हणजे नेमकं काय?' असाच प्रश्न मला वयाच्या एका विशिष्ट टप्प्यावर पडला. त्यावेळी सुदैवाने माझ्याजवळ एक पुस्तक होतं. ते मी तत्पूर्वी वाचलं नव्हतं पुस्तकाचे नाव आणि माझ्या मनातील अस्वस्थता यामुळे माझं मन त्या पुस्तकाच्या दिशेने ओढलं गेलं. जोडायचे असतात. म्हणजे ते साहित्य स्वतः पुरतं चिरंजीव होतं. करमवणूक करून घेताना स्वतःला त्यात खर्ची घातल्याशिवाय ती करमवणूक अंतरंगी भिनत नाही." साहित्य हे चुन्यासारखं असतं त्यात आपल्या विचारांचा काथ घातल्याशिवाय आयुष्याचा ग्रंथ रंगत नाही.

भारत देशाला अतिप्राचीन काळापासून अस्तित्वात असलेली 'गुरु' करून घेण्याची परंपरा लाभली आहे. मलाही माझ्या आयुष्यात ज्यावेळी 'गुरु' हवा होता. अशा वेळी तो गुरु मला प्रथमदर्शी प्रा. डॉ. गणेश राऊत व अॅड. प्रा. प्रतिक घोष तसेच एच. व्ही. देसाई महाविद्यालयातील प्रामुख्याने कला शाखेचे तसे सर्वच शाखांचे अध्यापक-प्राध्यापक यासर्वांच्या रूपाने मिळाले. अफाट वाचन आणि आपापल्या क्षेत्रात उत्तमता आणि निपुणता संपन्न केलेले. यांच्यामुळे मला समजत आणि उमजत गेलं की, आपण नेमकं या वयात काय वाचलं पाहिजे. या सर्वांनी दिलेली व सुचवलेली पुस्तके, जन्मदिनी भेट मिळालेली व मी विकत घेतलेली अशी सर्वच. या सर्वांच्या वाचनाने मला जाणवत गेलं की, 'भू-तलावर उत्तम साहित्य कृतींचे वाचन करत राहणे यासारखं दुसरं ऊर्जादायी आणि आनंददायक काहीच नाही.' काही पुस्तके आपल्याला झपाटून टाकतात. अंतःकरणात भावनांची प्रचंड खळबळ उडवून देण्याची शक्ती त्यांच्यात असते. अशी पुस्तके कधी विस्मरणात जात नाहीत. दीर्घकाळ टिकणाऱ्या सुगंधाप्रमाणे ती पुस्तके मनात दरवळत राहतात. नाटकाच्या पुस्तकातले संवाद इतके काव्यात्म, अर्थगर्भ आणि भावस्पर्शी असतात की, प्रत्येक नवीन वाचनाच्या वेळी अधिक उत्कट अनुभूती देत राहतात. अशा वाचनाची नशा काही वि लक्षणच असते! सुखाविषयीच्या माझ्या कल्पनेतून पुस्तके वगळली तर सारं सुखच संपुष्टात आलं असं म्हणावं लागेल. एखाद्या क्षणी हृदयाच्या अगदी जवळची माणसेसुद्धा आपल्यापासून दूर होतील, त्यांच्याकडील काही गोष्टी आपल्याला देण्यात संकोच करतील. परंतु, पुस्तके ही कधीच विश्वासघाती असत नाहीत. त्यांना फक्त स्पर्श करण्याचा अवकाश असतो. ज्ञानाची कवाडे ती लगेच सताड उघडी ठेवतात. भावनांनी आणि विचारांनी ओसंडणारं त्यांचं अंतःकरण ती मोकळे करतात. कदाचित ती म्हणत असतील की, माझ्या अंतःकरणात त्या थोर लेखकांनी साठवलेलं हे भांडार तुझंच आहे. जे तुला आवडेल ते



तू खुशाल घेऊन जा.

मला जेव्हा एखादं पुस्तक हवं असतं तेव्हा मी ते राऊत सरांना मागतो आणि मला ते पुस्तक देतातही. परंतु, ते देताना एक वाक्य नेहमी सांगतात की, "जसच्या तसं, माझं पुस्तक वाचून झालं की मला आणून दे." यावरून त्यांची पुस्तका विषयीची आत्मीयता जाणवते. तेच पुस्तक जर घाण करून परत दिलं असतं, तर त्यांना किती वाईट वाटलं असतं. पुस्तकप्रेमी पुस्तकांना लेकी प्रमाणे जपतात. बहुदा दुसऱ्याच्या हाती देताना जणू लेक सासरी जातेय की काय असेच त्यांना वाटत असेल.

दया पवार यांचे 'बलुतं' हे पुस्तक माझ्या वाचनात आलं आणि त्यातून मला मी अनुभवलेल्या आणि सत्तरीच्या दशकातील लेखकाने अनुभवलेल्या दलित समाजाचे वास्तवदर्शी दर्शन झाले. हे पुस्तक जेव्हा मी हातामध्ये घेतलं, तेव्हा मी त्यातील मुखपृष्ठावरूनच काहीसा आतील आशयाचा अंदाज बांधायचा प्रयत्न केला. परंतु तो लेखकाने साफ खोटा ठरवला. दगडू नामक व्यक्ती त्याचेच टोपणनाव असणाऱ्या मारुती याला त्याची दर्द भरी दलित समाजात जीवन जगत असतानाची कहाणी सांगतोय. हे दलित साहित्यातील पहिले आत्मकथन. याला आता ४३ वर्षे पूर्ण होऊन गेली तरी, अजूनही ते वाचताना आता घडत असलेल्या घटनांसारखे डोळ्यासमोर तरळून जाते. सोपं आणि खरं लिहिणं फार कठीण असतं. कठीण आणि बरं लिहिणं फार सोपं असतं. पण दया पवार यांनी 'खरं आणि बरं' असे दोन्ही प्रकारचे लेखन यामध्ये केले आहे. मोठी माणसे मोठीच का असतात? या प्रश्नाचे उत्तर एखादे पुस्तक, कादंबरी, लेख वाचला की कळते.

मला जी. ए. कुलकर्णी यांसारख्या अत्युच्च दर्जाचे लेखक आणि त्यांचे लेखन समजणे, त्यांचा अर्थ माझ्यापरीने लावणे म्हणजे ऊन-सावल्यांचा खेळ वाटतो. जेव्हा-जेव्हा त्यांच्या कथा वगैरे वाचतो तेव्हा-तेव्हा ते नव्याने कळत जातात.

ललित आणि वैचारिक साहित्यातून मिळणारे अनुभव वैशिष्ट्यपूर्ण तर असतातच पण त्यातून काही नव्या प्रेरणा वाचकाला प्रवाहित करतात. कथा, कादंबरी, आत्मचरित्र, आत्मकथन यांच्याबरोबर कविता संग्रह येतो. कवितेच्याद्वारे कमी शब्दात अधिक भावार्थ तोही प्रभावी पोहोचवणे किती तपस्वीतेचे असते. सुरेश भटांच्या गझला, कवी ग्रेस, संदीप खरे, गुरु ठाकूर यांच्या कविता जीवन कसं असावं याविषयी सांगतात. जगण्याला बळ आणि हिंमत देतात.

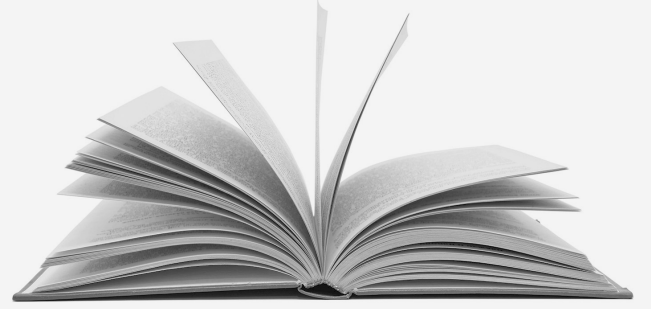

Tadoba... Tiger and Me

In the era of rapid urbanization and hustling lives, what gives peace is serene, rustic, green jungles. The purity of the air and tranquility around is a soulful experience. The lush green trees, meadows, grasslands, ponds, rivers and clouds enrich the inner self. I am fortunate to have experienced this in the jungle of Tadoba. Tadoba, through the years has become my go to destination. It's refreshing, energizing and enriching.

Tadoba is a protected area situated in Chandrapur district of Maharashtra. It's bustling with tigers as of today it, holds a healthy population of around 120 plus tigers. Apart from the tigers, one can also see leopards, sloth bears, wild dogs, blue sambar deers, spotted deers, etc. It is a birding Paradise with a wide range of raptors, passerines and small forest birds. The reserve is spread across 577 sq.km. and is a jewel in the crown of tiger conservation of India. It is Maharashtra's oldest and largest national park. Acquiring its name from the local deity 'Taru', Tadoba has a rich history of Gond kings and local tribals. The forest is bisected with a meandering Andhari river. To break the green monotony, it has numerous lakes, streams and ponds. The Tadoba lake amidst the forest is a sight to behold. Resting on its banks, is the temple of Taru who is propitiated in order to protect the tribe from tiger, leopard and sloth bear attacks. Principally, the locals seek coexistence but spillover populations of wild animals are recording increased frequency of man-animal conflict.

Tadoba and me –

For me, going to Tadoba tantamounts with sighting a tiger. I had visited many tiger reserves ranging from Kanha, Bandhavgad to Sunderbans. Different areas, different terrains, different stories but no sight of tigers. I almost came to the conclusion that I will no longer visit a tiger reserve since tigers were not a part of my

destiny.

And then on one fine day, my daughter put up a proposal before me saying that Tadoba will not fail you and I should be going on a trip to Tadoba. Not much willing though, I fell prey to her assurance and joined her group which was to go for a visit to Tadoba. All the arrangements were done, tickets and hotel bookings finalised and I started with my holiday to Tadoba. With absolute surety that it would be just another jungle trip, I moved on.

The season was good. It was sometime in February. The company was wonderful. The only doubt was the tiger.



As per the plan, there were four jungle safaris; two in the morning and two in the afternoon. The plan looked exciting, the description of the jungle was mesmerising, theory was all perfect, practical was yet to happen.

We started with the first safari which was early in the morning. The weather was bright and jungle

was lush green. There was lot to observe, lot to see, lot to learn and of course lot to enjoy. For about three and half hours we moved through various parts of the jungle, cited some animals, saw a range of birds in wild, saw for the first time a ghost tree, which was indeed something very new. I started to realise that I was enjoying the jungle. The guide with the safari was trying to put in all the efforts to show us his royal majesty. But we came back empty handed. Still, everybody around was hopeful and positive. So I too kept my hopes up. After a bit of resting and a grand lunch at the resort we moved with the next safari. New hope, new vision and we moved on. This time we saw a bear, a pack of wild dogs, crocodiles, and then as we were moving, we suddenly saw a large number of gypsies waiting and looking towards the water body. Our driver positioned our gypsy and yes I saw the tiger sitting in water, completely ignoring the people watching on. I was speechless. I was widening my eyes to see his royal majesty. It was my first actual view of a tiger in the wild. Our guide informed us that this tiger was named "Chota Matkasur". If this was chota how huge would be the actual Matkasur! Just could not relate to it. But I had made it. I had seen a tiger in Tadoba. I was one of those Tadoba visitors who would boast of seeing a tiger live in jungle. I was immensely thankful to our guide, driver and of course chota Matkasur. I was an achiever. Very glad and happy we moved on. We were in the core region of jungle. Well-built roads, lush green trees, and large number of gypsies were in sight. And then again suddenly our driver stopped because another gypsy in front of us stopped. This was on the tar road itself. A face emerged from the front side of the gypsy in front of us. A huge tiger was walking towards our gypsy. Our driver pushed our gypsy in reverse and for about one and a half kilometre we were going reverse

and the tiger was approaching. There was pin drop silence. We were glued. After walking for about one and a half kilometre on the road the tiger crossed the road and disappeared in the jungle. It was a life time experience for me, for everyone who saw that.

We needed to rush back as the timing of the safari was close to end. On returning to the resort we were thrilled, excited as if now we didn't need anything more. The next day morning we started with our last safari. I was relaxed as I had got



what I wanted. We sighted a leopard, an animal which is very close to tiger. We had a smooth ride and were about to exit from the jungle. As we approached towards the exit gate suddenly my daughter asked the driver to stop. She had spotted a tiger coming out of the jungle from one side and was crossing the road. This tigress was Sonam as the guide told us. She also walked for quite a bit of distance on the road and then went into the jungle. I was stunned, such a superb finish to the Tadoba trip. I returned to Pune with a heart, full of memories which I knew I would carry throughout my life.

No mobile phones are allowed in the jungle. The rules are very strict. No getting down from the gypsy, no loud voices, music and yes no plastic to be thrown.

On coming back to college as I described my experiences many of my colleagues expressed the urge to visit Tadoba with their spouses and families so we planned a trip. It was a big responsibility but I accepted the challenge and got the work going. We decided on dates in May, during vacation. It was understood that it would be very hot in Tadoba but I had no option. We reached Tadoba, a group of 22, it was great fun, we as college colleagues had never been out together with families. The plan was of four safaris and I had crossed my fingers for tigers. But as we set out in the very first safari, we sighted two favourite tigers of Tadoba, Taru male and Choti Madhu. My colleagues were delighted. The very first safari had given them very special Tadoba gift. And after that almost every safari we sighted tigers. Chota dadhyal, Taru, Madhu, 2552, all of them.

Indeed, a very productive trip. Tadoba doesn't fail has become the tag line for me.

However, I know that jungle is just not about tigers, it's much more, still a trip to jungle feels incomplete if you don't see one. There is other side to this too. 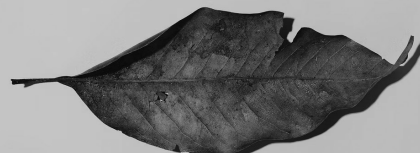

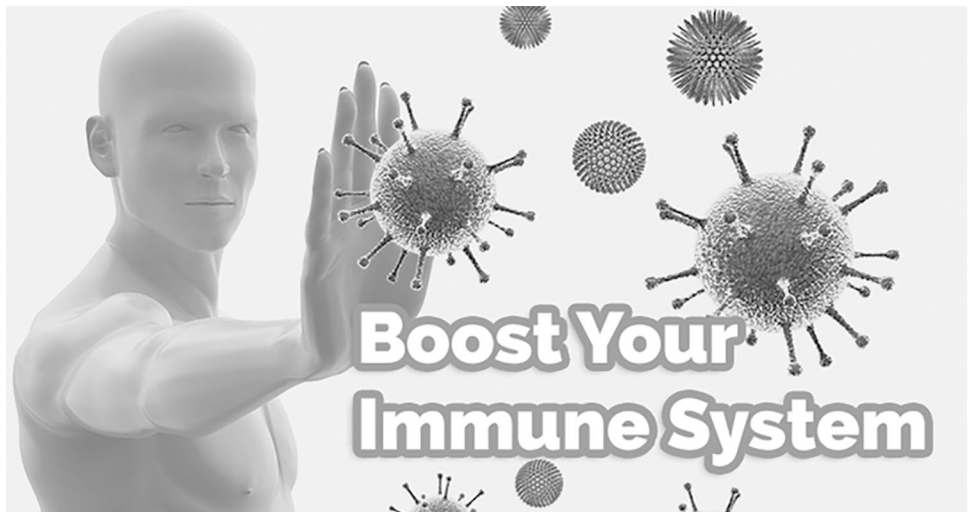
Immunity system is the defence mechanism of our body. When a foreign body or germs enters your body, your body activates its immune system to kill that foreign body or germs. White blood cells (WBC) play an important role in the immune system. Your immune system does an amazing job of defending you against disease-causing microorganisms. But sometimes it fails. A germ invades successfully and makes you sick. To function well, the immune system requires balance and harmony. Like any fighting force, the immune system army marches on its stomach. Healthy immune system warriors need good, regular nourishment.

College can be one of the most challenging times to stay healthy. Suddenly, things like basic nutrition and sleep are taken for granted, resulting in sluggish immunity, hormonal issues, exhaustion, and many more. The causes of sluggish immunity are late nights, stress and bad food. The most common symptom of mind-body imbalance in college students is low spirits. Basically, college students need energy to be happy, have a stable mood, sleep through the night, and focus. Students should follow a healthy lifestyle to improve the immune system.

Your first line of defence is to choose a healthy lifestyle. Your immune system functions better when you are protected from environmental offensives and boosted by healthy-living strategies such as

- Exercise regularly and maintain a healthy weight

- Eat a diet high in fruits, vegetables, cereals, pulses
- Get enough sleep
- Take steps to avoid infection, such as washing your hands frequently
- Try to minimize stress
- Practice meditation, Yogasana, and Pranayama



- Avoid Smoking, alcohol and other addictive substances.

Some stress can be a good thing. It helps your body get ready for a challenge. But if it lasts too long, that's dangerous for your health. Too much stress releases the hormone known as cortisol, which impairs your response to immediate surroundings and makes your body susceptible to infections; you are left feeling constantly anxious. The best way to relieve stress is through meditation, it is a tried and tested activity to calm the nerves. Stress can lead to lowered immunity and make you more prone to illness. Colorful fruits and vegetables including berries, carrots and spinach have antioxidants that protect you

against oxidative stress, which translates to a stronger immune system.

Certain bad habits like smoking and alcohol consumption have a direct correlation between weakened body defences and respiratory illnesses. Smoking is proven to weaken your lung capacity and destroy the cells lining your respiratory tracts, these cells are crucial to fight viruses that enter through your nasal orifices. There is new research claiming that individuals who engage in heavy alcohol consumption tend to suffer from ARDS (acute respiratory distress syndrome) which is one of the conditions caused by Covid 19 infection.

Regular exercise is one of the pillars of healthy living. It improves cardiovascular health, lowers blood pressure, helps control body weight, and protects against a variety of diseases.

Sleep is important not only for rest and rejuvenation, but also for supporting the immune system. It is when we sleep that the immune system is replenished and strengthened. Losing even one night of sleep can significantly suppress the immune system. Melatonin, a natural hormone, is released when darkness falls. It makes us feel drowsy and helps us to achieve a deep and restful sleep. However, as well as helping with sleep, it is a powerful antioxidant that helps to support immune system function, so that while we are sleeping the immune system is functioning to support healing within the body.

An immune-boosting food includes a combination of vitamins, minerals, proteins, antioxidants, and other compounds which boosts your immunity. The food you eat plays a key role in determining your overall health and immunity. Eat low carbohydrate diets, as this will help control high blood sugar and pressure. Focus on a protein-rich diet to keep you in good shape. Regularly consume vegetables and fruits rich in Beta carotene, Ascorbic acid and other essential vitamins. Foods like mushrooms,

tomato, bell pepper and green vegetables like broccoli, spinach are also good alternatives to build strength in the body against infections. Mushrooms are loaded with selenium and vitamin B complex, minerals that help to boost your immunity. A good mushroom-dish loaded with veggies works wonderfully to boost your immunity.

There are natural ways to ward off the germs. Some natural immunity boosters include ginger, gooseberries (amla) and turmeric. Some of these superfoods are common ingredients in Indian dishes and snacks. There are several herbs that help in boosting immunity like garlic, basil leaves and black cumin. Certain seeds and nuts like sunflower seeds, flax seed, pumpkin seeds and melon seeds are excellent sources of protein and vitamin E. Turmeric is a bitter, yellow spice commonly used in cooking. It contains curcumin which has anti-inflammatory and antioxidant effects on the body. Curcumin is an immunity booster and acts as an antiviral. A cup of Turmeric Milk every day can improve your immunity. Garlic has powerful anti-inflammatory and antiviral properties which enhances body immunity. Allicin, a compound in garlic, is well-known for its ability to boost the immune system. The most benefit comes from eating one-half of a raw garlic clove daily. Vitamin C is a crucial participant in the army of immunity. It helps prevent the common cold. It acts as a powerful antioxidant and protects against damage induced by oxidative stress. For severe infections, including sepsis and acute respiratory distress syndrome (ARDS), high dose intravenous vitamin C treatment has been shown to significantly improve symptoms in patients. Vitamin C is available naturally in many fruits and vegetables like oranges, broccoli, kiwi. Vitamin D has a mild protective effect against respiratory tract infections. Zinc is a vital component to WBC (white blood corpuscles) which fights infections. Zinc deficiency often

makes one more susceptible to flu, cold and other viral infections.

Robust gut bacteria protect to us against infection. Keep those bacteria healthy with prebiotics that contain fibre. Probiotics are live intestinal bacteria that help improve the digestive ability of your system and build a strong immunity to diseases and problems relating to the gut. The human body is home to both, harmful bacteria as well as beneficial bacteria. Probiotics improve absorption of nutrients, improve synthesis of vitamins, essential fatty acids and prevents some bacterial and fungal infections. They are beneficial bacteria that help the body in fighting the harmful bacteria. Regular intake of probiotics is an easy way to keep diseases and digestive issues away. They improve digestive health, reduce depression and promote heart health. They even give you better-looking skin. We can get probiotics from buttermilk, curd, yoghurt, cheese and pickles and from fermented foods. Low-fat curd and fermented dairy products are rich in probiotics which can boost your immunity and keep you healthy. These products also rich in proteins, fats, vitamins which help to enhance your immunity.

Citrus fruits like oranges, grapes are an excellent source of vitamin C. Vitamin C boosts your immunity and reduce your cold, cough suffering duration by improving your immunity. Egg yolks are full of nutrients that enhance your immunity. Egg contains vitamin D and proteins which helps to keep you safe from cough and cold.

A positive mindset is vital for health and well-being. The positive thoughts reduce stress and inflammation and increase resilience to infection while negative emotions can make you more susceptible to the common cold and flu. Beauty and the Beast

Neelima tried hard to make her speak, open up her heart but Anupama wasn't responding at all. During last six months, Neelima's success was that atleast the lady had revealed her name, only first name. Neelima somehow felt attached with Anupama, this was very strange, she always pondered. During my last 15 years of practice, this never happened. I have treated so many patients with different issues but never I was involved with anyone, this is so unprofessional, why am I having soft corner for this lady? Who is she? what's in her that's attracting me? Is it her extraordinary beauty or the eyes which reveals the story of agony and pain she suffered through and still survived and which she didn't disclose with her mouth.

In a sudden flashback, Neelima was reminded of the first day, when police brought Anupama to the centre, horrified, almost unconscious, bruises all over her body, brutal harassment everyone said. Police said she was found in one corner of the railway station hiding behind the parcels. After primary medical investigation, it became clear that she wasn't raped or sexually assaulted. All the staff members of the centre thanked God for saving this lady from the clutches of beasts. Many said, they were reminded of the story 'Beauty and the Beast', after observing the condition of Anupama.

The wounds and bruises of the Anupama's body healed within next 6 months but the injury marks on her mind were still fresh, that was visible through her painful eyes. Neelima tried almost all the healing methods but they were of no use. She searched all the books and tried to find out the similar cases treated earlier by various psychological counsellors all over the world and she came to the conclusion that time is the only remedy for such deep internal mental bruises.

Neelima is one of the famous psychological counsellor in the City but instead of doing

individual practice she preferred to work in government mental Asylum. She was of the opinion that the patients in government Asylum needed her most and she has been working there since almost 15 years. Anupama's case was becoming more challenging for her but she liked challenges. She poured her all experience, expertise and knowledge to bring back Anupama to normal. Soon she sensed few improvements in her condition.

Anupama now started smiling a bit. she came out of the room and used to sit under the Gulmohar tree in the garden of the Asylum for hours. Slowly she regained her strength and stamina, she loved to wander in the garden. Her eyes shined when she was in the company of nature, Neelima's One of the observations about her. After Neelima's instructions, she was assigned the work in kitchen. Anupama was happy and enthusiastic to help there. But still she kept aloof and mum. Being psychologist, Neelima had lots of patience. She awaited.

Within next six months, Anupama was almost settled, she now mixed with other patients over there. She was no more a burden. She started looking after many responsibilities of the Asylum. She was a good help in kitchen, gardening and keeping records. Neelima understood, Anupama is well educated woman. And now she started doubting about her mental health. Neelima thought purposely she is hiding her information and whereabouts.

Police also investigated about her family, no missing complaints were found. Her photo was published in newspapers but no soul turned to take her responsibility. So day by day Anupama's case was becoming a mystery.

Almost after a year, after Anupama's entry in Asylum, doctors declared her fit and healthy after medical investigation. So as per rules now she has to leave the Asylum. Neelima also signed on that report. But Anupama wasn't informed

about it yet.

And it was new year day, all were rejoicing when police brought a mentally ill lady who lived on the footpaths of the city, she was brutally gang raped during night by a group of drunkards. All were stunned to see her condition, but it was Anupama, who became violent after observing her condition, she started growling, shouting, she rushed into the kitchen, returned back with a knife and was grumbling I won't leave him, he has injured one more, I will kill him. Somehow she was calmed and Neelima was called immediately.

Anupama be calm. Neelima tried to soothe her. She was still fumbling with anger. She was shouting.

He has spoiled my life. He killed me slowly day by day. He is a beast in gentleman's clothes. I left my family, my dear ones behind for his love what was my destiny, I wasn't aware. I am completely alone now. My family disowned me. And here I ended in Mental Asylum. I am a software engineer, I am from Himachal Pradesh, from a middle class happy family, I would have listened to my parents's advice and married my childhood friend and lived happily. But my destiny was something else. I met him in Delhi where I was working in a software company. While returning back from office, at metro station, 15 years ago, he saved me from group of drunkards who were teasing me. I immediately thought I love him, he was a handsome guy of nearly 30, tall, fair, curly hair, attractive smile. He introduced himself as a doctor practising in some private hospital down town. We started meeting everyday after the office hours, at the end of month, he declared his love and proposed me. I was in cloud nine. I told my parents about him but they immediately rejected him as he belonged to different caste. They threatened me to disown if I married him. We married in the presence of few friends next weekend. He said he had no relatives and lost his parents in a road accident during his childhood. I showered him with all love, care, affection he was missing from the childhood days. The golden

days of honeymoon were over and his real face turned out. He started keeping watch on me, he sometimes followed me to the office, checked my mails, social media messages on my phone. He started doubting me. In the beginning I thought he was possessive about me. But later I realised, he was sick. He started beating me when he was drunk. I tried my best to convince him and took him to the doctor for treatment, what a joke, he himself was a doctor. After he came out of that phase many times after weeks, he used to say sorry, he promised he won't repeat the mistake again. But he was never reformed completely. Fortunately I didn't conceive due to some gynecic problem otherwise I would have spoiled one more life. You would wonder, why I lived with him, when he was such a beast? Hope madam, I had a vain hope, he will recover one day and everything will be ok. But he killed me everyday, nowhere to go, I suffered but last year he almost turned violent and attacked me, I ran away, the sufferings of last 15 years made me dumb.

What's his name Neelima asked, we will register a police complaint against him.

"Dr. Rohit Mishra", Anupama muttered.

Neelima shuddered after listening his name again after 15 years, a wave of shock almost grasped her.

Anupama asked her, "Are you ok?"

Neelima said, "Sorry dear, I would have filed a complaint against him 15 years back so you wouldn't have suffered this, our divorce case was going on 15 years back, when you met him, I was married to him for 5 years and had a hellish experience, so I applied for divorce, he was not ready to leave me, but I think he met you and I was spared from the daily killing."

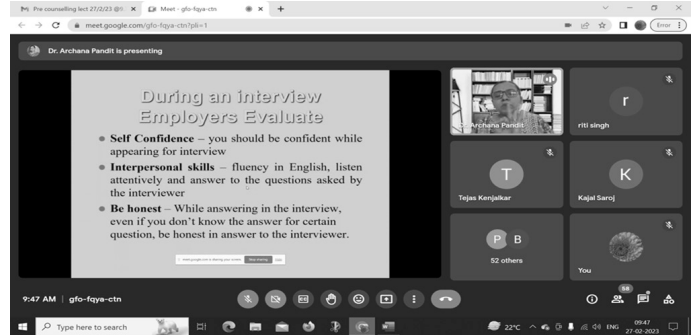

अर्थव्यवस्थेचा 'डिजिटल' चेहरा

डिजिटल इकॉनॉमी मूलभूत अर्थात अर्थव्यवस्था जी डिजिटल संपर्काची संरक्षणावर आधारित आहे, परंतु इंटरनेट आणि वॉर्ड वाढत येताना आधुनिक व्यवसायांचे व्यवसाय चालवते. यात इंटरनेट इकॉनॉमी, न्यू इकॉनॉमी किंवा वेब इकॉनॉमी असेही संबोधले जाते. 'डिजिटल इंडिया' पुढाकाराने तीन मुख्य घटक म्हणजे ई-गव्हर्नन्स, पायाभूत सुविधा, ई-कॉमर्स, 'डिजिटल इकॉनॉमी' म्हणजे वस्तू आणि सेवा, वास्तविक किंवा अन्य तयार करण्यासाठी किंवा माहिती संरक्षणाचा वापर. डिजिटल नॉलेजमध्ये डिजिटल बँकिंग, ई-वॉलेट, स्मार्टफोन अॅप आणि प्लॅटफॉर्म सहयोग यांचा समावेश आहे.



एक जुलै २०१५ रोजी पंतप्रधान नरेंद्र मोदी यांनी प्रामीण भागांना हल-स्पीड इंटरनेट नेटवर्कने जोडणे आणि डिजिटल साक्षरता सुधारणे या उद्देशाने 'डिजिटल इंडिया' संकल्पना सादर केली. यामध्ये डिजिटल इंडिया कार्यक्रमाचे 'दुई, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक सेवा, उपलब्ध आणि जोडणीचा संघी या क्षेत्रांचा समावेश आहे. या प्रकरे डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्था बांधणीची की वाईट पाहतात, अर्थव्यवस्थेचे डिजिटलव्हेरामधील पणवडे अचक्री करण्यासाठी निर्माण करते. कारण डिजिटल संरक्षण नावून-पुर्ण आणि इतर रचनागारच्या सोयी आणि आर्थिक वाढीस चालना देते. डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्था समाकल्पने सर्व विस्तार देऊन ठरवते. 'डिजिटल इंडिया' ही वेळ सुरुवातीस सुरु केलेली एक मोठी गोष्ट आहे; ज्यामध्ये सरकारच्या सेवा नागरिकांना इलेक्ट्रॉनिक पद्धती मिळतात. या उद्देशाने प्रामीण भागांना हल-स्पीड इंटरनेट नेटवर्कने जोडण्याचा प्रयत्न नैतिकता, सामाजिक रचना, अर्थव्यवस्था आणि सूक्ष्म योजना या चार स्तंभांवर बांधला गेला असून, त्याचारे माकरी विकासामध्ये, संरक्षणाचे नेमलेले क्रांतिकारी भूमिका बजावली आहे. 'डिजिटल इंडिया'ची गरज काढत असून, सरकारने डिजिटल सर्विसगव्हर्नन्ससाठी ई-गव्हर्नन्स, मोबाइल ई-गव्हर्नन्स सेवा आणि डिजिटल पाचघटत वास्तव्य विविध कार्यक्रमांचा समावेश करून 'डिजिटल इंडिया' उपक्रम सुरु केला. त्याचारे, देशात अर्थिक वास्तव अर्थव्यवस्था निर्माण करण्यासाठी माहिती संरक्षण आणि व्यवसाय प्रक्रिया व्यवस्थापन, डिजिटल कन्सुमेरिजम सेवा आणि इलेक्ट्रॉनिक्स उत्पादन वेगवान उपग्रह (जोडीची) दृष्टी टोपणीची गरजता आहे. डिजिटलव्हेरामध्ये आधुनिक अर्थव्यवस्थेच्या विस्तारास एक महत्त्वाचे स्थान प्राप्त केले आहे, ज्याने 'डिजिटल इकॉनॉमी'ला जन्म दिला आहे.

सध्याच्या संरक्षणाच्या उगमा, प्रारंभ सहजपणे वेबसाइटवर आणि इतर सोप्या मोडिटा प्लॅटफॉर्मवर विविध मोठ्या पाहतात, त्या मोठ्या प्रभाव पाहते. डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्था शिक्षण, आरोग्यसेवा, मनोरंजन, बँकिंग अदीह वापरकर्त्यांच्या जीवनातील एक वेगळे विस्तारण इंटरनेट हा कर्ण आहे. यामुळे मोठीस तास काम करता येते आणि ग्राहकवर्गाची कमीती पोहोचते. व्यवसाय, नवी उपलब्धी आणि सेवा तयार करण्यासाठी, स्पर्धात्मक निर्माण पोहोचतात, ग्राहकांना ठरव करण्यासाठी आणि वेळ बचवण्यासाठी देता वास्तव्य जाते. डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्थेची उपलब्धता वाढवण्यासाठी सर्व व्यवसायिक क्षेत्रांमध्ये माहिती आणि प्लॅटफॉर्म संरक्षणाचा (आयसीटी) प्रसार करण्यात आला आहे.

मेळावा कार्यपत्र, डेन्मार्क हा जगातील सर्वोच्च डिजिटल सर्विसगव्हर्नन्स देश म्हणून उल्लेखनीय झाला. भारताची डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्था २०१४ ते २०१९ दरम्यानच्या अर्थव्यवस्थेच्या युद्धात २.४ पट वेगाने वाढली आणि सुमारे ६२.४ दशलक्ष लोक्या निर्माण झाले. डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्थेचा आकार २०१५ मध्ये १००.७ अब्ज डॉलरवरून २०१९ मध्ये २२२.५ अब्ज डॉलर झाला आहे. २०२२ मध्ये जागतिक 'जोडीची'च्या ९० टक्के डिजिटल कन्सुमेरिजम संरक्षणात अवलंबून आहे.

तरुणांना कौशल्य आधारित प्रशिक्षण देण्याचे लक्ष्य ठेवण्यात आले होते. या योजनेच्या माध्यमातून तरुणांना उद्योग व्यवसाय क्षेत्रातील लागणारे कौशल्य प्रशिक्षण दिले जाते. जेणेकरून ते स्वतःचा उद्योग सुरु करू शकतील. ही प्रधानमंत्री कौशल्य विकास योजना आणि उद्यमिता मंत्रालयाची (MSDE) प्रमुख योजना आहे. या योजनेचा उद्देश मोठ्या संख्येने भारतीय युवकांना उद्योग-संबंधित कौशल्य प्रशिक्षण देऊन सक्षम बनवणे. जेणेकरून त्यांना उपजीविका चालवण्यासाठी मदत करेल. या योजनेअंतर्गत तरुणांना उद्योग संबंधित कौशल्य प्रशिक्षण दिले जाते, जेणेकरून ते स्वतःचा रोजगार सुरु करू शकतील. या योजनेंतर्गत, दहावी-बारावीमध्ये ज्यांनी शाळा सोडून दिली किंवा कमी शिक्षित तरुणांना प्रशिक्षण दिले जाते.

स्किल इंडिया मिशन अंतर्गत, युवा कौशल्य विकास योजनेत सामील होण्यासाठी युवकांना फी देण्याची गरज नाही. उमेदवार तीन महिने, सहा महिने किंवा एका वर्षाच्या कोर्ससाठी नोंदणी करू शकतात. अभ्यासक्रम पूर्ण झाल्यावर प्रमाणपत्र दिले जाते, जे देशभरात वैध असते. तरुणांना रोजगार मिळण्यासाठी रोजगार मेळव्यातून मोठी मदत होते. सरकार यामधून बेरोजगारीची समस्या कमी करण्यासाठीही प्रयत्नशील आहे.

आंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तरांनुसार प्रशिक्षण दिलं जावं, असा सरकारचा आग्रह आहे. दरवर्षी तरुणांना वर्क फोर्समध्ये समाविष्ट केले जावे. या योजनेंतर्गत बेरोजगार तरुणांना बांधकाम, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक्स, हार्डवेअर, फर्निचर व फिटिंग्ज, हस्तकला तसेच चामड्याचा उद्योग अशा सुमारे ४० तांत्रिक क्षेत्रात प्रशिक्षण दिले जाते.
